


# Newsletter 15, 5th May 2024 6th Sunday of Easter

New priests for our Parish (update): We have contacted the Archdiocese, and they are doing their best to keep us informed. The Archdiocese mentioned they have little control over the visa application process except for checking the credentials of the clergy and the congregations concerned. Even having done this there can be hiccups. Sometimes in the countries of origin the detail required for a visa application is not easy to obtain quickly. There are also differences in the dating of documentation (versus what is on an application) that need to be properly verified. Then once this is completed, health check details etc., can be discovered which can also lead to declining an application. In terms of our new priests getting to New Zealand, and to Marlborough, the Archdiocese has said the process is ongoing. However, the provincial of the order that our new priests belong to (Missionary Society of Mary) has assured the Archdiocese, that as soon as the visas are given, they will be on the next plane.

### Festival of Life Sunday - May 5th 2024

In baptism, through water and the word, a person is immersed in Jesus Christ, and journeys with Christ, through his death and resurrection to a new life. This week we celebrate an initiative of the Lutheran-Roman Catholic Dialogue. We highlight Baptism, and its significance for Christian unity. This initiative affirms the shared belief "in one baptism for the forgiveness of sins" as confessed in the Nicene Creed. Today we spend some time focussing on Baptism which is the seedbed from which Christians can develop a deeper appreciation of one another on our journey to wholeness.
